## Stove Top Pizza

- \*Large frying pan
- \*2 cups flour (I use all purpose)
- \*1/2 Tbls yeast
- \*2 Tbls Olive oil
- \*2 cups warm water
- \*Pizza Sauce
- \*Cheese and toppings of choice

Coat your pan with cooking spray or coconut oil. Dump flour, yeast, olive oil, water, and salt into the pan and stir, then using a spatula, spread out to cover the bottom of the pan. This will not look like regular dough. It will be goopy ( I know goopy is not a word, but it's the best description for this). Add your pizza sauce to the goop. Next add your toppings and cheese.
