Holy Family Homeschoolers COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Participate at Your Own Risk

All Holy Family Homeschoolers activities are optional. We are a support group. If you are part of a vulnerable population or uncomfortable gathering in person, do not attend. Feel free to plan virtual events. Parents are responsible for their children and following guidelines and mandates from the local state authorities. Please discuss your expectations with your children.

Restrictions for Participation in HFH Functions

Do not come to HFH functions unless:

- 1. you have been fever-free without the use of medication for the past 48 hours.
- 2. you have NOT had symptoms such as fever, cough, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, loss of sense of smell or taste, shortness of breath, headache, sore throat, muscle aches or chills for the last 48 Hours.
- 3. you have NOT been exposed to anyone who has tested positive with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.

Masks

COVID19 Exposure

If a household member tests positive for COVID-19 directly after attending a recent HFH function, you should inform the HFH director immediately. HFH will then inform members (without using names). HFH will then expect the affected family to decide on an individual basis their own course of action regarding notifying people who the COVID positive person was in direct contact with. The infected person will not be permitted to HFH events for the number of days recommended by officials at the time.

HFH Is Free of Liability

Holy Family Homeschoolers, its members, and anyone associated with HFH, are not liable for the contraction of COVID-19 by any HFH family member or another person who comes to HFH meetings or activities.
