Boys and girls are lost. Statistics show us that 80% of children do not regularly attend church. *Child Evangelism Fellowship*® wants to help you take the church to the children in your neighborhood. We do this through our summer *5-Day Club*® ministry.

5-Day Clubs meet for 5 days (Monday-Friday) for 90 minutes each day. Children learn memory verses, hear Bible lessons, sing fun songs, and play fun interactive games!

5-Day Clubs are taught by young people (ages 13 and older) who have attended Christian Youth In Action® training. These young people are equipped to teach *5-Day Clubs*. CEF will provide the teachers, curriculum, and prizes.

5-Day Clubs are held wherever children are - backyards, parks, trailer parks, apartment complexes, daycares, etc. Clubs can also be held in churches—VBS style.

The host of the *5-Day Club* provides a club location, invites the children, and provides a small snack for the children. After club is over, you will be given a copy of the enrollment sheets in order to keep in contact with the children and invite them to your church.

Guidelines for Social Distancing and safety

- All clubs will be held outside, weather permitting. If it is rainy, the club will not take place that day if there is not an indoor space where there can be social distancing.
- All 5-Day Club workers will have masks and hand sanitizer when needed.
- Please do not allow your child to attend if they are sick/not feeling well.
- Each child will have a designated spot to sit during the teaching time.
- Instruct children as part of the rules do their best to stay 6 feet apart, not touch other children.
- No sitting on laps, even of siblings
- Hand sanitizer will be available for children to use as much as they feel they need.
- All efforts will be made to keep children at a safe distance during any games that are played. All game equipment will be sanitized after each use.
- All snacks will be individually wrapped.
