Class Expectations:

- Attendance be on time!
- **Preparedness** Come to class with all your supplies (see list) and make sure you read the assignment **before** class. Have completed work ready to turn in to me.
- Participate actively in class discussions and labs. Be dedicated to your studies!

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Homework:

- One common assignment is the "On your own" or OYO problems. You'll find OYO's
 throughout your assigned reading and some will be discussed in class. Always complete
 them while doing the assigned readings. The answers are found in the text just ahead of the
 study guide questions; students should check their own answers for OYO's. You will be
 required to turn them in as part of your homework.
- Another common assignment is the end-of-the module Study Guides. Students should complete the Study Guides and a parent should check the answers (correct) using the solutions manual. Parents should have the student review and make corrections if necessary. This will help students better prepare for tests/exams.
- 3. Lab reports are required as a written record of the labs we do in class.
- 4. Homework and reading will be assigned five days a week, even on the "off days" when we do not meet. Please be diligent with this; we have a lot of material to cover! Plan to spend **45–60 minutes per day** on Biology.
- 5. Students will receive 1–2 quizzes on each module in class. Any notes taken when reading the text, and answers to any questions may be used for quizzes. These are designed to keep you accountable for your homework and prepare you for tests.

Semester Projects:

- Construct an analogy/model of a plant or animal cell for Module 6.
- Students will select a project from a list of various projects or, with tutor approval, design a project of their own.

Quizzes and Tests:

- 1. Module tests will be taken at home under a parent's supervision, with parent's signature, and quarter exams will be completed in class.
- 2. Quarter tests are prepared by the tutor.
- 3. Each of the first three quarter exams covers material covered in those quarters, whereas the fourth quarter exam covers 75% of fourth quarter material and 25% cumulative material.

Supplies — Bring to each class session:

- 1. Textbook
- 2. Any experiments
- 3. Pen (blue/black), pencils and eraser
- 4. 3-ring notebook —1 ½ inch. This will need to have 17 labeled sections:
 - Each Module 1-16 will be a section.
 - Section for projects and exam reviews
- 5. A 2-pocket school grade folder with metal prongs color coded for which hour of class you're in.

4th Hour - Green

5th Hour – Orange
