Course Description:

There is so much more to the study of history than names and dates! History is a fascinating series of stories about a group of people – a compendium of stories from widely diverse cultures. To study history, we need to understand how it influenced – and was influenced by – the literature, music art, foods, geography, cultural mores, and current events of the times.

- Twentieth Century: A World at War
