Textbook: None required. (The tutor may take some lessons from **Drawing Textbook** by Bruce McIntyre.)

Supplies needed for class: (Most, if not all of these supplies, can be purchased at Michael's or Economy Art & Frame. If your student has these supplies from last year and they are still usable, that's fine — please see what may need to be replenished if necessary.)

- ◆ Ebony or 6B dark pencil
- ◆ #2 (school) pencil
- ◆ Kneaded eraser
- ◆ Set of colored markers
- ◆ Colored pencils
- ◆ Set of oil pastels
- ◆ Sketch pad (9 x 12" or larger)

Course Description This class will concentrate on sharpening drawing skills and helping students develop their own style of drawing. We will be building on skills acquired in Drawing I and learning more advanced techniques. The drawing class will include (but not be limited to) the following techniques:

- ◆ Drawing with pencil, charcoal & conte crayon
- ◆ Shading techniques
- ◆ Outdoor sketching
- ◆ Pen & ink techniques
- ◆ Markers
- ◆ Colored pencils
- ◆ Pastels
- ◆ Watercolor/acrylic paints
- ◆ Portraiture
- ◆ Illustration

We will be learning about famous artists and illustrators as part of class. Students will have brief drawing homework assignments each week.
