

SOUTHERN CROSS CHRISTIAN CO-OP is seeking an Art instructor

Southern Cross Christian Co-op (SCCC) is a homeschool cooperative dedicated to supporting and partnering with Christian parents who educate children at home. We strive to provide opportunities for our children's social, intellectual and spiritual growth through planned educational and recreational activities. Our families work together to promote Christian values and character development, and to provide opportunities that will nurture and grow a child's mind and heart to be conformed to the likeness of Christ.

We are currently seeking independent contractor candidates to provide Art instruction for children aged Kindergarten through 5th grade beginning in September 2018. Class guidelines and expectations are detailed below. SCCC meets from 11:30AM – 4:00PM the first and third Tuesdays of September—May for a total of 15 meeting dates. The instructor is responsible for developing four classes using the guidelines provided and by assessing the student's abilities as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates must share SCCC's beliefs as outlined in our Statement of Faith and profess a personal, saving relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ. Experience with young children is required. Previous teaching experience is preferred but not required.

DESCRIPTION

This class will focus on introducing and encouraging a love of art. Art instructor will teach techniques in a variety of mediums (such as paint, pencil, charcoal, and pastels), supervise, assist, and encourage creativity. The instructor will be expected to adjust the class to adapt to children with differing abilities. Successful candidates will have strong speaking and listening skills in order to communicate instruction effectively. Basic supplies suggested by instructor will be brought by the students; however, instructor will be responsible for providing all necessary supplies and equipment for each lesson (a reasonable art fee may be charged to students).

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

May be invited by the SCCC Board of Directors to participate in special events (annual parent meeting, picture day, etc.).

COMPENSATION

This position is a fee contract of \$30.00 per classroom hour equal to \$1,800.00 for the co-op year. Payments to be preceded by invoices submitted on a semester basis. There are no benefits associated with this position.
