Dr. Steve Aubuchon

Dr. Steve Aubuchon is the director of the Upper Grades Concert Band, Swing Apprentices, the Intermediate Band, and Beginning Band. Dr. Aubuchon grew up in South St. Louis County and attended DuBourg High School. After playing freshman football for six weeks he decided to learn to play the French Horn. While in the orchestra he met Mary Jane. They have been married for 33 years and have two sons, a daughter-in-law, and a granddaughter (tons of pictures available upon request) and another grandchild due in September.

Steve's higher education began at St. Louis Community College at Meramec. Then after a brief time of active duty with the Missouri Air National Guard, he attending the University of Missouri-St. Louis and earned a Bachelor of Music. Since then he has also received a Master of Music Ed. from Vander Cook College of Music in Chicago, and a Ph.D. in Curriculum and Instruction from the University of Missouri-Columbia.

Since his graduation from UMSL Steve has held full time positions teaching instrumental for 33 years until he retired from the public schools in 2005. Most of those years were spent with St. Charles City Schools. His teaching experiences range from pre-school to graduate levels. Dr. Aubuchon is also retired from the Air National Guard.

In addition to his position with St. Charles Christian Home Educators, he is very busy with the music ministry at All Saints Parish.
