Course Description:

This advanced writing class is designed to prepare your students for collegiate writing. Students will gain valuable experience through varied writing assignments such as rhetorical analysis, research papers, argumentative essays and much more. Students will also gain exposure to the MLA and APA writing formats, PowerPoint presentations, and critical thinking exercises in order to be as prepared as possible for their college writing experiences. All teaching will come from the Excellence in Writing Teaching Model.
