

# JCHE Activity Descriptions

## CLUBS/GROUPS

### 4-H Clubs

For homeschooled students. Each club meets monthly in and around Johnston County, NC.

### Art Club

This monthly painting activity is open to all ages. The tweens and teens usually paint on their own while the younger children follow instructions tailored specifically for them.

### Early Homeschoolers/Tweens/Teens/Junior-Senior

These groups are formed for families with children in various age ranges. Each group plans monthly activities including field trips, park days, museum field trips, factory and business tours, farm tours, play groups, themed parties, etc. Participating families pay any expenses. Most events are free. There are several gatherings during the year, such as Christmas Party, Valentine's Party, Hot Dog Roast, etc.

### History Club (Tarheel Junior Historian)

JCHE offers a history club which meets monthly (weekly in the Spring) to work on various projects to be submitted for competition at the annual Tarheel Junior Historian Association Convention at the North Carolina Museum of History in April of each year. The club is consists of three subgroups (3rd-5th, 6th-8th, 9th-12th).

### Yearbook Club

JCHE publishes a professional yearbook. Led by volunteer coordinators and staffed by high school students who sell ads, sell yearbooks, raise funds, collect photographs, lay out the pages, write copy, etc. The staff also coordinates and sponsors the annual school pictures. Yearbook staff meetings are held regularly, one or two times a month.
