JCHE is registered as a Scripps Spelling Bee participating school. JCHE sponsors a Spelling Bee for JCHE students in grades 1-8. The winner of our Middle School competition (grades 6-8) goes on to compete at the county level with other Middle School winners from area public and private schools in Johnston County. The winner of the County Bee goes on to compete nationally at the Scripps Spelling Bee in Washington D.C. There is no charge to student participants.

Tarheel Junior Historian Association Contests

Each spring, the North Carolina Museum of History hosts the THJHA Annual Convention. The day includes hands-on workshops and activities as well as the announcement of the winners of THJHA Annual Contests and Awards.

Annual Contests include Artifact Search; Christopher Crittenden State History Quiz; Exhibit (Art); NC Historic Architecture Photography; Historical Essay (four themes); Literary; and Video Documentary. Winners are showcased in the THJHA exhibit at the museum.
