

## TEACH Wellness Policy

We are asking families self-monitor for symptoms and err on the side of caution. If you or any member of your immediate family is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, vomiting/diarrhea, or a fever in the past 24 hours, or have had contact with someone who has COVID-19 **we ask that the entire family stays home.**

In the event of illness, please keep the family home until the illness is no longer contagious (i.e. 24 hours fever and symptom-free for most illnesses; for Covid we ask you follow the guideline of waiting until 10 days after symptoms first appeared AND 24 hours with no fever).

While having a sick child is a hardship for most families, it is important that parents follow the “golden rule”. If your child becomes sick while at co-op, please take them home out of courtesy to other families. Thank you for considering these recommendations and implementing them during our co-op year.

If you or a student become symptomatic and tests positive for Covid within three days after a co-op day, we'd ask that you notify the steering committee by emailing us at the [teach.toledo@gmail.com](mailto:teach.toledo@gmail.com) address. We will let classmates/teachers know of the exposure; however, identifying information will be kept private.
