COACH'S CODE OF CONDUCT:

By coaching or being an assistant coach, I am agreeing to uphold the following guidelines and appropriate dress for all practices and games:

1. I will demonstrate the character quality of self-control by not participating in activities such as profane language, alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, pornography, gambling, or immorality. I will be a good role model for our players at all times.
2. I agree with CHEF's Statement of Faith as stated in the CHEF Athletics Handbook. (Located on CHEF's website: chefok.org)
3. I will wear appropriate dress at all practices and games. See CHEF Athletics Handbook.
4. I agree to have a clean-cut appearance for the season. No radical hairstyles or colors. No visible tattoos, or no body piercing (except for women's earrings).
*Men – No earrings, long hair, or ponytails.
5. I agree to submit to the authority of the officials and the Athletic Committee. A coach who receives a technical foul, whatever the nature, must notify the Athletic Director within twenty four (24) hours after receiving a technical foul. All coaches' technical fouls will be reviewed by the Athletic Committee. Should the technical be unsportsmanlike or behavioral in disposition, the receiving coach may be asked to serve a one game suspension. Any coach with habitual unsportsmanlike technical fouls during the season may be asked to step down from his/her position.
6. I desire as a coach to not draw attention to myself but rather build unity with CHEF players and parents. "Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for the brethren to dwell together in unity." Psalm 133:1 (NKJV)
7. I understand that if I fail to abide by the Code of Conduct, the CHEF Athletic Committee has the authority to ask me as a coach or assistant coach to step down.
8. I agree to follow all CHEF guidelines in both letter and spirit and strive to keep myself and my athletes in compliance with CHEF Athletics guidelines.
