Parent's Code of Conduct:

I/we recognize that by allowing my child to play on this basketball team that I will be actively involved in the following ways:

1. I am currently home educating my child and he/she is passing. If my child does not maintain satisfactory academic and spiritual progress, I will notify the coach or the Athletic Director.
2. I will require my child to abide by the team rules and program guidelines (See Athlete's Code of Conduct).
3. I will remain under control during all games.
 - * I will exhibit Christ-like behavior toward the officials, my child, our players or coaches and the opposing players, parents or coaches.
4. I understand and agree to abide by the following appeal process:
 - * If I have a problem with someone, I will talk with that person seeking a resolution.
 - * If we are not able to resolve the situation then I will meet with the person and the Athletic Director.
 - * If no resolution is reached I will then meet with the person, the Athletic Director and the CHEF Athletic Committee.
 - * If there is still no resolution, it will then be at the discretion of the CHEF Athletic Committee to bring the matter to the CHEF Board.
5. I recognize that CHEF Basketball is a competitive basketball program and that playing time is at the sole discretion of the coach based on his decision as to what will make the team the most successful. (Different rules apply to elementary teams.) Furthermore, I agree to support the coach in his decision whether I agree with him or not.
6. I understand that if I fail to abide by this commitment statement that the CHEF Board has the authority to ask my family to leave the program and that we would not be entitled to any refund.
7. I understand that I must be a member of CHEF to participate in this program and agree to be current with my dues.
8. I agree to actively participate in the CHEF Athletics program by fulfilling work assignments for home games and other team responsibilities.
