



Cornerstone offers multiple full-year language classes for Spanish, French, and German. Explore a language or fulfill a college requirement:

Pre-Calculus

Full Year, 12:30-1:25 - Mr Mark Campbell

This class will provide students with background to key mathematical concepts needed to prepare for calculus. Topics include trigonometry (definitions, operations, inverse functions & identities), rectangular & polar coordinates, functions, domain & range, logarithms, sequences & series, limits, and imaginary/complex numbers. Graphing of functions will be reviewed. Course will include one-hour weekly class, weekly assignments, quizzes, and unit tests. Prerequisites for this course include Algebra II and Geometry, with a minimum grade of C achieved for each of these classes. Textbook: PreCalculus with Trigonometry, published by Math-U-See, 2010.

Character Building Literature

Spring- 11:00-11:55 - Mrs. Catherine Sharp

This 15 week middle school level literature course offers the chance to add to your reading list for the year with books rich in character building themes. Comprehension questions and related activities will be assigned to keep the group of students engaged so that class discussions can be lively.

Music History

Fall-11:00-11:55 - Mrs. Jaclyn Umholtz

This class is a general music class (similar to that which is offered in a public school to middle schoolers) and will be aimed toward 7-9, but it is not exclusive to those grades. Students will study musical elements and music history as well as learn how to listen intelligently to music among other topics. The class will include hands-on activities and projects in class as well as at home to reinforce and facilitate learning. This class would be valued at .25 credit towards High School Music or Humanities.

Art History

Spring- 11:00-11:55 - Mrs. Ellen Campbell

This course will begin with art in the Ancient World and will continue until present day. We will cover a variety of works and artists from many different cultures. Students will be expected to be prepared to participate in weekly discussions on the topics and take short notes on the provided note sheets. There will be several projects assigned throughout the semester such as a short research paper and presentation and an art timeline portfolio along with an art project. There will be two tests.

Yearbook

Full Year, 10:00-10:55 - Mrs. Erin Groff

Using the TreeRing Program, students work collaboratively to create the Upper Tier yearbook from start to finish. This group is tasked to record our Cornerstone year through the eyes of the students both in class and at extracurricular activities. The class applies graphic design, photography, interviewing and copywriting skills learned each week during class to their assigned pages. Students also organize and promote spirit days. Access to a digital camera or phone is helpful. Homework will be required.

Music Theory

Spring- 11:00-11:55 - Mrs. Jaclyn Umholtz

Students will be learning the fundamentals of music theory and then applying that knowledge by composing music and finally performing on instruments they have built. This is a great class for students looking to earn honors credit in music.





We, the Firmly Planted community, are a group of families like-minded in our desire to educate our children with excellence in such a way that the treasure of learning truth about God, His world and His work become their delight, and that communicating the Gospel becomes their passion. By coming together as a team, we as teachers become more equipped that we may equip our children to stand firm, and bear fruit, communicating truth with both skill and grace.

In our community, we use the Classical Christian model of education, emphasizing memorization for the younger students and continuing with logic and reasoning skills in the higher elementary grades. We have found the classical model to be refreshingly scaleable among different learning styles and capabilities, facilitating cyclical learning that provides repetition over time and allows gentle absorption of knowledge according to the student's developing capabilities.

Community Day Classes

Assembly: Community wide Scripture memory and devotions.

All Ages (4 years-7th grade):

- -New Grammar: Memorization of facts and information across seven subject areas with fun songs, hand motions, etc. Includes history and world timeline.
- -Presentations: Weekly practice in public speaking and active listening skills.
- -Science: Hands-on experiments and projects working through the Scientific method within a Socratic dialogue, where questions guide students to discovery.
- -Music: Music theory concepts are gleaned from engaging lessons using instruments and voice.
- -Art: Learn fundamental skills, study great artists and their work, try creating in their style.
- -Spanish: Engaging topical vocabulary presented with lots of conversational repetition and songs.
- -Story time: Age appropriate (picture book or novel) read-alouds provide imaginative continuation of topics learned (preschool-3rd grade).
- -Math Games: Age appropriate games that encourage speed and accuracy in addition and multiplication, or logic and reasoning challenges (1st-7th).
 - Writing with Structure and Style (Institute for Excellence in Writing): outlines, paragraphs, stories, research and more in historical thematic context, made approachable and attainable (4th-7th grade).
 - English Grammar: intricacies of English Grammar presented in a fun, approachable and logical way (4th-7th grade).


