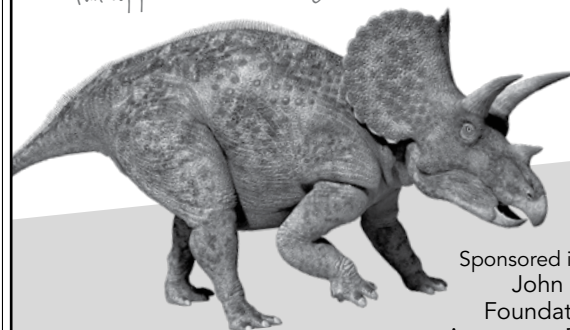

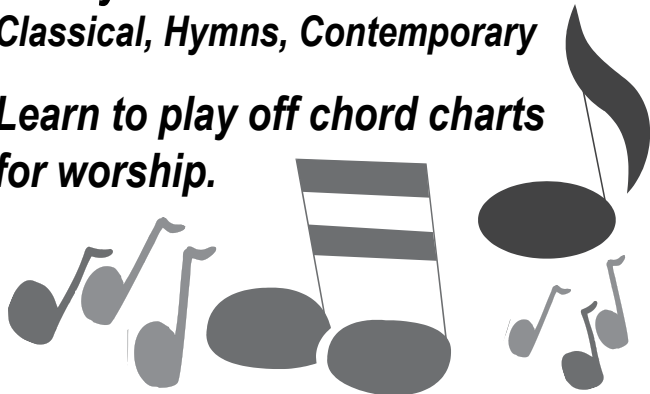

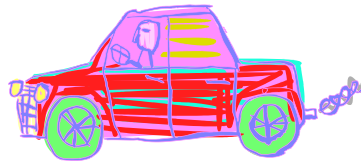

You may also include the time of day you would prefer to teach: i.e. morning, afternoon, all classes in a row, time between some classes if you are teaching multiple classes. Although we do not guarantee these we do try to accommodate them. 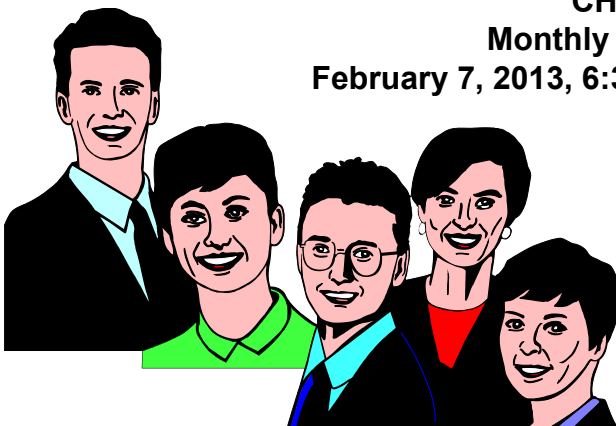

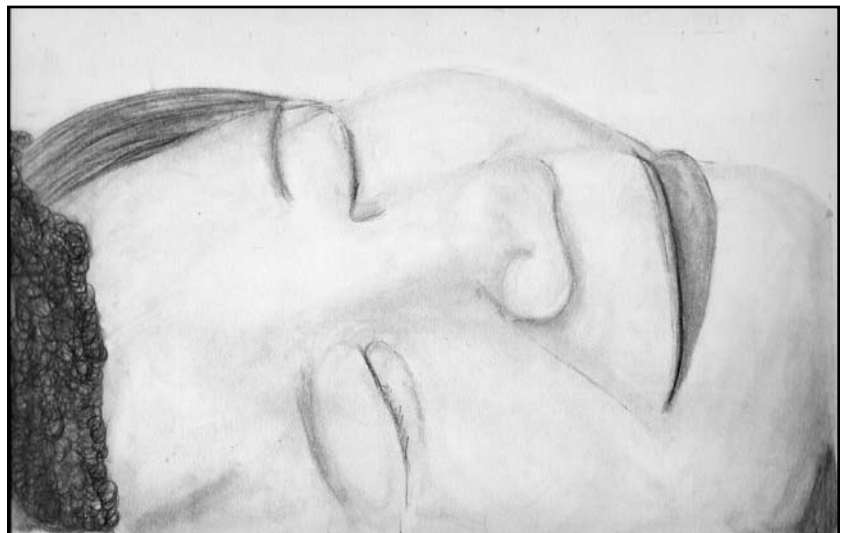
