Which track is right for you?

Co-op track

(Required for families with students under the age of 12. Full-benefit option for families with 7th-12th graders.)

Upper level only track

(An alternative membership path for families enrolling 7th-12th grade students)

Classes for infants through 12th grade

Classes for 7th -12th grade (minimum age of 12 by September 15.)

Parent-member teaches/co-teaches three classes and assume one extracurricular duty or the equivalent. Parents serve as monitor if child is enrolled in ULA classes.*

Parents may serve as monitors to reduce registration fee.

Admittance requires the approval of the steering committed based on submission of an application, affirmation of the statement of faith, review of references. It is also contingent upon class space.

Families may register for classes online after co-op track members register. Upper level only track members must agree to respect and abide by the policies which are guided by our statement of faith. They should also understand that classes are taught from a Christian worldview.

Pays an annual registration free of \$95-125 plus a \$30 CHALC member fee.

Pays a \$30 CHALC member fee.

Pays the class fee for all ULA teachers. ULB classes are free. No additional UL registration fees are charged unless member opts out of monitoring**.

Pays the class fee for all ULA & ULB classes*.
Also pays \$30 per class per semester registration fee. Members who agree to serve as monitor** pay only \$10 per class per semester registration fee.

Co-op track students may participate in the Theater Arts program and/or serve on the Student Council.

The Theater Arts program is not open to upper level students. Students may not serve on the Student Council but may participate in Student Council sponsored events.

Families enoy a number of extracurricular perks like track and field, closing program, free tickets to theater arts presentation, and field trips.

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Students are encouraged to attend the teen opening from 9-9:15 a.m. every Wednesday morning and to get to know their peers in the social study hall between classes.

*7th through 12th grade courses are divided into two categories. ULA courses typically run 15 weeks and are taught by independent contractors. ULB courses may run 10 -15 weeks and are taught by co-op track parents.

**The number of monitoring slots assigned will be no more than two per ULA/ULB class per semester for ULO track or two per ULA class per semester for co-op track.
