All participating Students must agree to the following Player Code of Conduct:

- Players will obey their parents, coaches, assistant coaches and referees at UHC athletic events and while traveling to such events. Talking back, arguing, and undue familiarity with UHC coaches will not be tolerated.
- Players are expected to treat prayer with proper reverence. Jokes, songs, conversation or behavior that treat the Lord's name, character, or institutions with triviality are not permitted.
- Players will demonstrate honesty in all their dealings with one another and their coaches. Players will respect property and belongings of others.
- Players will play diligently striving to do their best at all times.
- Players will refrain from rough physical contact with other students such as hitting, punching, and tripping.
- The possession and use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or weapons of any sort is strictly forbidden on the school grounds, at any practice or game or while being transported to a practice or game.
- Players will refrain from language and actions which are vulgar, inappropriate and demeaning to either God or mankind. Inappropriate teasing, criticizing, put-downs, insults and name-calling are not permitted.
- Players will refrain from all forms of inappropriate sexual behavior.
 Public displays of affection (e.g. holding hands, kissing, etc.) at any UHC athletic event are not permitted.
- Players represent UHC when in public and as such will wear UHC-issued uniform in appropriate manner before, during, and after athletic events.
- Players will take good care of uniforms turning them in at the end of the season and will not wear them to any non-UHC event. Loss of uniform will result in a \$50 charge.
- Male players will not wear any jewelry and female players will not wear any jewelry except for stud earrings to any UHC athletic event.
- Players will abide by the same hair guidelines that UHC students must abide by. Specifically hair is to be of natural, human color.
