I. Categories

On the **Forum page**, you will see that the forums are split into categories. **General Forums** can include all or only a select number of students and families. If you can see the category title, then you will receive notifications for new forum posts. The number next to the category title shows you how many posts are within that forum category.

III. Reply to a Thread

IV. Delivery Preferences

Each family has the ability to change their delivery preference when it comes to forums.

To make these changes, you'll want to start by selecting **Profile** in the top navigation bar.



On your **Profile page**, you'll want to scroll down until you reach the **Forum Emails section**. Your main options are whether you'd like to receive email notifications and if you do, how often you would like them sent. You can also choose which categories you want to be notified about. If your child needs to receive the daily emails from their classes, then you will need to make sure you select **Many Emails**.



Once you've made your changes, scroll to the bottom of the page and select **Update**.
