

Supply List for School

Bring on the First Day of School

Goggles or safety glasses for chemistry experiments

Index cards (blank on one side)

One box of facial tissues

One bottle of hand soap

One container of sanitizing wipes

Pencil pouch or box containing:

No. 2 Pencils

Erasers & Small Personal Pencil Sharpener

Ruler & Protractor

Scissors

Ballpoint pens – blue

Highlighters – 3 to 6, depends on individual student use

Colored pencils – a nice set would be best, but even the inexpensive sets work fine

Glue sticks – 2 to 3, depends on individual student use

Scotch-type tape - 2

Three 1½ or 2” binders: one of each color: red, white, and blue with a clear pocket on the front for science, history, and language arts

One 1” binder: black with a clear front pocket for timeline

One 1½ or 2” binder: any color you choose for your Master Project with clear front pocket



Subject divider self-stick tabs - they will need at least 40.

Wide or college-ruled loose-leaf paper – at least one ream.

Graph paper

Sheet protectors: at least 50

One ream of printer paper to give to the teacher for your notebook printouts

One ream of cardstock of the student’s choice of white or a light colors for their timeline to be printed on. Must be at least 100 pages.

All the above items are to remain at school in their cubby so they are available every day for the students while they are in class. The exception is if they need to take home their notebooks and/or literature texts for homework. They must bring them back every day.

All of the following books must be purchased new or used at the beginning of the school year and kept at the school until they start reading them with the class.
