SADDLEBACK CHRISTIAN ACADEMY COVID 19 GUIDELINES

Saddleback Christian Academy will follow all Covid 19 guidelines set forth by our host church, Calvary Chapel Mission Viejo.

Requirements for SCA Members (parents, students, guests):

- Masks are to be worn indoors except when eating and drinking or otherwise instructed.
- Provide your own hand sanitizer (60% minimum alcohol) to all classes and events/gatherings.
- Provide your own EPA approved sanitizing wipes when on campus to use for any chairs or desks used.
- All must be free from any Covid, Cold, or Flu-like symptoms: fever, cough, runny or congested nose, headaches, sore throat, muscle aches, loss of sense of smell or taste, shortness of breath, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, rash.
- Temperature must be less than 100.4 without the use of any fever reducing medications.
- Follow social distancing recommendations.
- Please do NOT attend any class or event if you or anyone in your household was directly exposed to someone who tested positive for Covid.
- No sharing of food or drinks.
- SCA will disinfect commonly used surfaces such as counters, door knobs, handwashing facilities throughout the day and as needed. Instructors will spray down classes with an EPA approved sanitizer after each class period.
- Doors will remain open in the classrooms as well as front entry during high traffic times. Front door may be closed for safety reasons for small gatherings.
- ❖ CCMV has hired a cleaning crew to perform thorough cleaning of high traffic areas such as foyer, halls, worship center, classrooms, and libraries three times each week.

Plan for a Covid Outbreak:

Crystal Nelson, Administrator, is to be notified immediately if any SCA parent, student, or recent guest tests positive for Covid. SCA will work with CCMV and follow all recommended governmental guidelines including proper communication with all SCA members.
