**>>Questions to be answered while signing up:**

- Parent's name and email (These are the first boxes on the signup form.)
- Number of performers in your family (Number of Attendees on the signup form.)
- Name(s) of the performers
- Age(s) of the performers
- Type of act being performed
- Song being used (if any)
- Length of act (Less than 1 minute and 45 seconds)

### **GUIDELINES**

*This year we have a maximum number of acts we can accept. Sign-ups are on a first come first served basis. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.*

**Length of act:** solo acts need to be 1 minute 30 seconds - 1 minute 45 seconds max. 2+ performers in a single act may be allowed extra time only if necessary and granted by the committee. Large group acts will be evaluated by the committee and given the appropriate time allotment.

**MANDATORY Dress Rehearsal:** January 19th, 12:15pm. Each act and full costume must be shown in its entirety to the committee at the Dress rehearsal and will be evaluated then.

**Content of act and costume:** The content and costume(s) in each act needs to present Godly values. Please follow all SBFA rules and policies.

**Participation Maximums:** Each participant is allowed to perform in 2 acts maximum (Academy Day Class Performances will not count towards the 2 act maximum).

**Non SBFA Siblings:** Non SBFA siblings may be permitted to perform only in a supporting role with their SBFA siblings and with committee approval.
