I-10 traveling East (from Katy):

Exit Smith, Right on Prairie, Left on Bagby

I-10 traveling West (from Beaumont):

Exit San Jacinto/Main, Left on Main, Right on Capital, Left on Bagby

I-45 traveling North (from Galveston, League City):

Exit Houston/Memorial, Right on Memorial, Right on Bagby

I-45 traveling South (from Conroe):

Exit McKinney (Exits to the left), Left on Bagby

I-59 traveling North (from Sugarland):

Exit Louisiana, Left on Capital, Left on Bagby

I-59 traveling South (from Humble):

Exit Hamilton, Right on Capital, Left on Bagby

225-610 West (from Pasadena/Baytown area):


Take 45 North, Exit Houston/Memorial, Right on Memorial, Right on Bagby

290-610 South (from Brenham/Austin/Jersey Village):

Take I-10 East, Exit Smith, Right on Prairie, Left on Bagby

TO ENTER THE PARKING GARAGE

Individual Car Parking ONLY (No Buses are permitted to park in the garage)
Parking rates: 2 hrs- \$6, 3 hrs- \$9, 4 hrs- \$12, and 4+ hrs \$15. Garage entrance heights is 7 feet 2 inches.

From Bagby, heading south:

Turn right on Walker St. and stay in the right lane. Turn right at the last drive, which is the entrance to the garage

From Bagby, heading north:

Turn left on Walker St. and stay in the right lane. Turn right at the last drive which is the entrance to the garage

From Walker, heading west:

Continue through the intersection at Bagby and stay in the right lane. Turn right at the last drive, which is the entrance to the garage

From Memorial, heading east:

Exit Rusk and continue heading east through the intersection at Houston. Immediately after crossing over Buffalo Bayou, turn right into the parking garage.

AUDIENCE ETIQUETTE

Thank you for attending our show. Please remember that appropriate laughter, tears, and applause are the best ways to express your feelings about the performance. Please remind your students of appropriate audience etiquette prior to the show.

Some things to remember while at the theatre:

- 1. No chewing gum, food or drinks are allowed in the theatre or the lobby
- 2. Photography and both audio and video recording (even with a camera phone) are strictly prohibited in the theatre
- 3. Absolutely no weapons of any kind are allowed in the theatre
- 4. Please keep your feet off the seats, refrain from placing your feet on the rails and do not climb over or step on the seats.
- 5. Stay with your group at all times. Wait for the ushers to help you find your seats
- 6. Lights will dim just before a performance, and then go dark. Show your knowledge by sitting calmly and guietly
- 7. No talking or whispering during the performance
- 8. Appropriate responses such as laughter are encouraged!
- 9. Please remove your hat before entering the theatre
- 10. Do not use electronic devices in the theatre and please remember to silence your phones
- 11. Disruptive behavior, improper language or any discourtesy to other audience members, performers, and/or theatre personnel will not be tolerated

12. Enjoy the show!! Think about your theatre experience during and after the performance. How does the material apply to your life? Are there lessons to be learned? Would you make the same decisions as the characters in the circumstances given? Did the performers inspire you or teach you about a different place and time in history? Are you happy, angry, bored, or encouraged by what you saw? Think it through and talk about it with others after the show!
