What? Escape from St. Louis is a challenging and fun activity to solve a series of clues and problems within a group setting. SHARE families will be in ***“Escape from the Tomb”*** where ***archeologists have been working to uncover the secrets of the Tomb of an unknown Egyptian mummy but have locked the site to unwanted visitors.***

As a team of grave robbers, our latest venture is to uncover the hidden treasures locked inside the burial chamber of the Tomb. Make it past the archeologists’ safeguards and ancient Egyptian traps and find ourselves a very rich team!

The group in each room has only one hour to get a final solution, so everyone must be willing to work together.

Who? The age we recommend is 12 years old and above because of the demands of concentration and problem-solving; however, if a parent will be in the room guiding younger children who can express their thoughts on the game, that is acceptable. Also, it is suggested that student/adults are acquainted with one another and sign-up with the intention of working together as a group. So, try to plan with some other families that you know, and keep in mind the limit per room is 10. Otherwise, we can put a group(s) together because it will be only families from SHARE. Note: If you have younger children and are dropping off older ones, Maplewood has many types of shops and some restaurants, so an hour would go fast if you chose to walk, look around and shop.

We have never scheduled a trip like this before, so it will be interesting.
