Included below are some details about the event so you can begin to plan and prepare.

For the first time SBFA Open House will have a **Chili contest**. Parents and students are welcome to bring your best chili and share it with our school. There will be a prize for the best tasting chili.

Competitive Entries

Each category will be judged in grade ranges (K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12). All work must have been completed during the 2019-2020 school year. Students may enter as many categories as they would like to.

Art Competition

Students may submit one entry in each subcategory listed below.

- Two Dimensional Art
- Three Dimensional Art
- Crafts (useful or wearable items)

Baking Competition

Students may submit one entry in each subcategory listed below.

- Cake Decorating
- Best Tasting Chocolate Dessert
- Best Tasting Non-Chocolate Dessert
- Best Tasting Gluten-Free Dessert

Creative Writing Competition

Students may submit one entry in each subcategory listed below.

- Short Story
- Poetry

Engineering and Architecture Competition

Each student may submit one entry. Ribbons will be awarded for the best original projects. In this category students may submit inventions, machines, vehicles, buildings, models, or dioramas. They may also submit original projects built with K'Nex, Snap Circuits, Tinker Toys or any building set other than LEGOs.

LEGO Competition

Each student may submit one entry. Ribbons will be awarded for the best original LEGO projects. Completed LEGO kits may be displayed with the non-competitive entries.

Science Project Competition

Each student may submit one entry. This competition will be organized in the style of a traditional science fair. Students should conduct an experiment and create a display. They will also be required to give an oral presentation to the judges.

Students will be judged based on the following criteria:

- Originality
- Use of the Scientific Method
- Visual Displays
- Oral Presentation

Individual Student Entries

An individual student may submit up to three entrees. All work must have been completed during the 2019-2020 school year. These projects will be on display for the enjoyment of everyone attending the Open House.

Family Display Boards
