



S.H.A.R.E.'s First Ever "Living Museum Night"



What's a Living Museum? Have you ever seen the movie *Night at the Museum*? Well, we can make history come to life right in the Homelink cafeteria!

When is this event? Tuesday, November 19, 2019 Museum opens at 6:30 pm

Where is this event? The Homelink Cafeteria, St. Andrew's Catholic School,
309 Hoffmeister Ave. 63125 (There is no entrance on Hoffmeister...go around to the back.)

What does my child need to do?

- Students will choose a historical figure to research.
- Students will complete research on their own time and prepare a short oral presentation (approximately 1-2 minutes long).
 - This presentation will allow the student to take on the personality of their chosen person. The presentation will give a brief biography of the person and tell why they are historically significant. Presentations do not need to be memorized, but it should be practiced beforehand.
- On the Opening Night of the Living Museum, students will come dressed up as the person they researched.
- Students may also wish to bring artifacts (props) that will be displayed around them during the exhibit.
- Guests of the museum will be able to circulate around the room and be amazed as historical figures come to life and present their information!



What else do I need to know?

- This is a **FREE** event for any student—all ages welcome to participate.
- The Living Museum will be open to all family and friends at 6:30pm on November 19, 2019.
- Participating students are asked to arrive by 6:00pm in order to set up their exhibit space and do any last-minute preparations.
- Bring a snack to share. There will be a potluck table to keep bellies happy and brains learning. Drinks provided.
