## Tournament Rules

- HOME TEAM listed $1^{\text {st }}$ on schedule
- HOME TEAM wears white or light-colored uniform
- HOME TEAM provides game ball
- HOME TEAM provides official score book
- VISITING TEAM leads pre-game prayer
- VISITING TEAM provides clock operator
- VISITING TEAM wears dark colored uniform
- WINNING TEAM text game scores to:

- 4 minute warm up before games or until scheduled start time.
- Games will not start early unless agreed upon by both teams.
- Game duration:
- All divisions - Running game clock only stopping for time-outs. Last 2 minutes of each half clock stops on dead balls and time-outs.
- $10 \mathrm{U} \& 12 \mathrm{U}-16$-minute halves
- 14U \& 16U(JV) - 18-minute halves
- 18U (Varsity) - 20-minute halves
- Overtime:
- All divisions - 1 OT period of 2-minute
- $2^{\text {nd }}$ OT period is Sudden Death ( $1^{\text {st }}$ made basket wins)
- Jump ball starts each OT
- Time-Outs:
- 2 full time-outs per half, do not carryover from $1^{\text {st }}$ to $2^{\text {nd }}$ half
- 1 full time-out for each OT period, no carryover
- Shooting Bonus ( 2 shots) will take place at the $10^{\text {th }}$ team foul of each half
- No pressing a team that is trailing by 25 points or more
