ELA 12 *** = Half credit, semester long class that is a separate curriculum outside the CTE programs and is specific to the ELA 12 standards. The curriculum focuses on technical writing, *not* literature/novels. Technical writing includes portfolio: resume, cover letter, follow up letter, research papers, writing assignments, etc. **Students will need to have a signed academic credit form on file by count day, either fall or winter, in order to register for the credit.** The class is an independent study.

This credit may only be earned during the senior year.

Senior Year Math- credit earned during senior year through state approved CTE course

3rd Year Science- replace with completion of a Formal CTE Program (1 or 2. See definition below)

2nd Year World Language- replace 2nd year with completion of a Formal CTE Program (1 or 2. See definition below)

Completion of Formal CTE Program definition: to replace credit, student must complete the entire curriculum of the program. **Note:** some segments are covered in 1 year (1), while others require 2 years (2) of participation

Check your district's board policy for any potential credits related to personal curriculum.

Academic credits may not be accepted at major universities or by NCAA. It is recommended that students complete required credits through the local high school if entering a 4 year university or playing college sports.
