

Henderson Christian Homeschoolers Statement of Beliefs

We are strictly a group of Evangelical Christian Homeschooling families. Our purpose is to encourage each other in our Christian walk, as we home school our children. All members of Henderson Christian Homeschoolers are expected to agree to and follow the following beliefs as participants in our group.

What We Believe

The Trinity: We believe that there is one God in three persons: God the Father, Jesus the Son, and The Holy Spirit. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ was conceived by the Holy Spirit and was miraculously born of a virgin, Mary. We believe that Jesus is fully and truly God, and fully and truly man. Jesus is the only mediator between God and man, and only Jesus saves from sin. (Mat 28:19) (John 10:30) (Mat 3:16-17) (1 Cor 8:6) (John 14:16-17) (Luke 1:35) (John 3:16-17) (Rom 10:9) (Col 1:15-27)

The Gospel: We believe that the Gospel is the “Good News” of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus from the dead. The Gospel’s foundation surrounds the finished work of Jesus on the Cross. It has nothing at all to do with man’s works. Good works do not save. Bible doctrines do not save. Only Jesus saves. We therefore believe in telling people to turn from their sins and trust Jesus, who is up in Heaven, so that Jesus can save them from their sins. That is the Good News! The Authority of Jesus and the Bible: We believe that Christians are to live for Jesus and the Bible and not to live for sin. Christians are to take a stand against sin, and for Jesus and the Bible. (Col 2:8) (Rom 8:11) (Gal 5:22-23) (Gal 6:8) (Gal 5:25) (Gal 5:25) (Mat 28:18) (Acts 5:29) (Gal 1:8-9)

Prayer: We believe that prayer changes things. Prayer is to glorify God, and all prayer should be made only to God the Father, Jesus the Son, and The Holy Spirit. (Phil 4:6) (Luke 11:9) (1 Tim 2:5) (Jam 5:13-18) (Eph 6:18) (John 16:24) (Rom 8:26) (John 14:26) (1 John 2:1)

Marriage and Sexuality: We believe that the term “marriage” has only one, legitimate meaning, and that is marriage sanctioned by God, which joins one man and one woman in a single, covenantal union, as delineated by Scripture. We believe that God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of marriage. We believe that any other type of sexual activity, identity, or expression that lies outside of this definition of marriage, including those that are becoming more accepted in the culture and the courts, are contradictory to God’s natural design and purpose for sexual activity.
