# By Law Changes

1. Due to changes made to the website last year we would like to update all information regarding the e-loop and old website.
2. Due to conflicting dates with basketball tournaments we would like change the current bylaw:

## General Business Meeting

General Business Meetings shall be conducted twice a year within the first two weeks of August and within the first two weeks of **March**. Meeting date, time and location must be posted on the e-loop and website at least two weeks in advance.

### We would like to change it to say:

General Business Meetings shall be conducted twice a year within the first two weeks of August and within the first two weeks of **January**. Meeting date, time and location must be posted on the Calendar and Forum at least two weeks in advance.

3. Removal of Testing Coordinator section as this is no longer necessary per Arkansas laws.

4. Change to Graduation Committee:

The family must have joined SCCHEA prior to the last Tuesday in January in order to participate in graduation.

We would like to add that slideshows must be approved by the executive committee 30 days prior to graduation. Graduates will be given an approval or denial with a reason within 7 days. Graduate will have 7 days to resubmit for a second review.

We would also like to add that all receipts must be turned into the treasurer within two weeks of graduation in order to be considered for reimbursement or you forfeit the right to reimbursement.

Any funds remaining from graduation will be returned to General Funds.

A vote will be conducted online via SurveyMonkey two weeks after the fall business meeting. It will open on August 16th and close August 17th.
