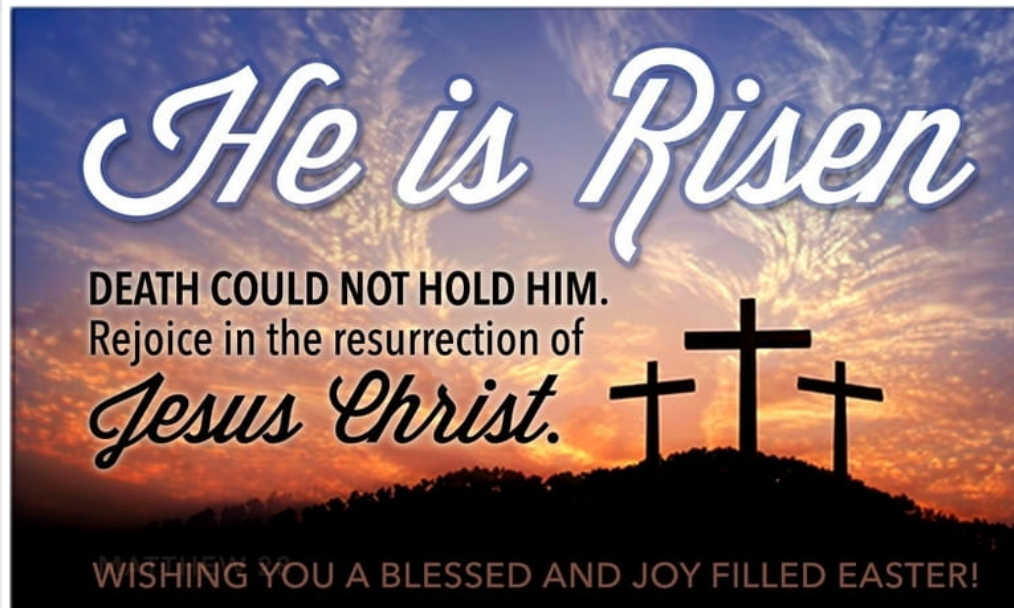
Student Council

Help Wanted

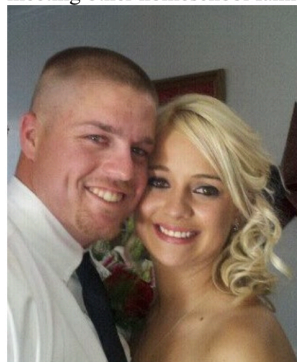
The PCHEA board is looking for volunteers! We are in need of a web coordinator. This position require someone who is detail oriented. This
