TRIVIA NIGHT

Rules

1. Trivia may be played as individuals or as teams. If playing in a team, only one device should be used for the team. Teams may not have more than four players. There will only be one prize given to the winning player or team.
2. Trivia will be presented using the online Kahoot! platform. It is the players' responsibilities to ensure they have a functional, charged, internet-capable device to use during trivia. If their device goes to "sleep", loses charge, or gets otherwise disconnected in some way during a round, there will be no "mulligans" or restarts.
3. Prior to every round, players will log into the game by going to <https://kahoot.it/> (not .com) and entering the game pin being displayed by the host. They will then enter their team or player name for the game. The chosen name should be kept the same for all rounds to assist in ensuring scores are recorded accurately; changing names could lead to forfeiture of points. Once all players/teams are logged in, the round will begin. If it is deemed that players or teams are taking too long to log in, the host may choose to start a 1-minute timer at the end of which the round will begin whether all players have logged in or not.
4. The first round will begin at 7:00 pm. The category for the first round will be Stately Nicknames. Each category contains 20 questions.
5. All trivia questions are multiple choice. Points are earned by answering questions correctly. Players will have 30 seconds to answer, but more points are earned for answering quickly. Each choice will correlate with a colored shape. The players' devices (phones, tablets, etc) will only display the colored shapes, NOT the questions and answers. Players select the colored shape they believe correlates with the correct answer.
6. If you believe an answer is incorrect, please forgive us: we are only human. Make a note of which question you believe needs to be corrected to share with the host at some later date. Due to time constrictions and the level of involvement required to

host such an event, corrections and point adjustments will not be made during Trivia Night.

7. Following every round, there will be a short break for players in order to allow points to be recorded. If teams or players change their team or player name between rounds, their scores will not be accurate.
8. The winner of each round shall choose the category for the following round. Below is a list of the eight available categories and a brief description of each. Due to time constraints, not all categories should be expected to be played.
 - a. **Stately Nicknames** - This will be the category for the initial round. For this category, players will have to choose which state a plate comes from.
 - b. **The Declaration of Independence** - Players will test their knowledge of one of America's most important documents.
 - c. **Fruit Bowl** - Players will answer questions about fruits.
 - d. **Famous Ships** - Throughout history, some ships have made names for themselves for a variety of reasons. Can you name them?
 - e. **Household Geography** - These trivia questions link something that might be found around the house to various geographic locations.
 - f. **2018 In The News** - Can you remember details about some of 2018's biggest (or not-so-big) headlines?
 - g. **Old Testament People** - The Old Testament is filled with historic people who's lives helped paint a picture of the Savior-to-come. But can you recall some quirky details about these people?
 - h. **Musical Movies** - Players will have to answer trivia questions about musicals.
9. We may not play all rounds; we will only play as many rounds as we have time to. After the end of the final round, which shall be announced by the host, the three players or teams with the most points shall be declared 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners.
