1. BRITISH RED ENSIGN (1707-1801)

PROVIDENCE OF GOD

Crosses of St. George [England] & St. Andrew [Scotland] flown over British forces from 1707-1801. Under this flag young George Washington led the Virginia Militia in accompanying General Braddock's British Redcoats to Fort Duquesne. They were ambushed by the French & Indians. Hundreds were killed or mortality wounded, including Braddock. Word was that George Washington had also died!

DEPENDENCE ON GOD

After news of the Declaration of Independence arrived, Washington wrote orders to his troops, which included the following:

"The Hon. Continental Congress having been pleased to allow a Chaplain to each Regiment, with the pay of Thirty-three Dollars and one third per month--The Colonels or commanding officers of each regiment are directed to procure Chaplains accordingly; persons of good Characters and exemplary lives--To see that all inferior officers and soldiers pay them a suitable respect and attend carefully upon religious exercises. The blessing and protection of Heaven are at all times necessary but especially so in times of public distress and danger.--The General hopes and trusts, that every officer and man, will endeavour so to live, and act, as becomes a Christian Soldier defending the dearest Rights and Liberties of his country. The Hon. Continental Congress, impelled by the dictates of duty, policy and necessity, having been pleased to dissolve the Connection which subsisted between this Country, and Great Britain, and to declare the United Colonies of North America, free and independent States: The several brigades are to be drawn up this evening on their respective Parades, at Six O'Clock, when the declaration of Congress, shewing the grounds and reasons of this measure, is to be read with an audible voice."
