

Common Sense Christian Homeschool Co-op

Overview Information

We are a Christian Homeschool Co-op, and all member families will be expected to read, agree with, sign, and adhere to our Statement of Faith. All classes will be taught from a Christian Worldview with no apologies or exceptions.

All interested families will be required to complete a Family Application Form for membership consideration. This application includes your church information as well as authorization to complete a criminal background check.

Our co-op openings are not filled on a first come first serve basis. We look at the make-up of each family to see if there is a spot for each of their children before making a final decision.

We are an academic-based co-op offering Science, History, and an elective hour for students in grades 2-12. We also have classes for younger students with academic instruction and activity time.

We are a parent-led co-op, and as such, each parent will be expected to facilitate one class and assist in one class. We do our best to place people in their area of gifting and experience, however, due to the structure of the co-op and classes offered this isn't always possible. We encourage all parents to be flexible and willing to step outside their comfort zone. This is a very encouraging environment where we can all learn and grow together!

We charge a \$200 per family per year participation fee for the co-op. This does not include curriculum or special class fees (for example art, home ec, gym, biology, etc).

We meet on Mondays for a total of 30 weeks during the academic year. This will be split into two 15 week semesters. Our day begins with a large group time at 9:15 am, includes 3 hours of instruction and a half-hour lunch break, and our day ends at 1:00 pm.
