T.E.A.C.H. Dress Code Policy

The T.E.A.C.H. organization has developed a basic Dress Code for our activities/classes/formals/dances. We wish to leave as much as possible up to the parents' discretion. However, we would like to request that each person be considerate of others in how they choose to dress.

The intent of this Dress Code is to promote a healthy environment for everyone in T.E.A.C.H. Any type of dress, behavior, or practice which creates a dangerous situation, infringes upon the rights or safety of others, is immodest, profane, portrays nudity, sexual innuendo, or is otherwise inappropriate for Christian homeschool events will not be allowed. Students and parents should consider the following questions:

- Does my clothing expose too much?
- Does my clothing advertise something that is prohibited to minors?
- Are there obscene, profane, drug-related, gang-related or inflammatory messages on my clothing?
- Am I dressed appropriately for the weather and/or the activity?

We are a family organization so please dress respectfully for the sake of everyone present. The homeschooling community has a wide range of clothing preferences among our member families so here are a few requirements to keep in mind when participating in T.E.A.C.H. events/activities:

- Dresses/skirts/shorts guideline - not shorter than mid-thigh.
- Please no midriff showing.
- Conceal the cleavage.
- Undergarments should not be exposed because of tight and/or loose- fitting clothing.
- At T.E.A.C.H. pool/lake/beach events, swimsuits should be modest. No "Speedo-style" for the guys. No 2-piece suits with exposed midriff for the gals. If wearing a bikini/skimpy 2 piece, please cover with a dark t-shirt or swim cover up.
- No students will be allowed to carry weapons at T.E.A.C.H. events.
