This program gives nutritious, easy-to-prepare food to children who may not have access to adequate meals.

Thirty homeschool children have already signed up for participation. Because these children are homeschooled, they <u>do not</u> have access to food assistance through the public school system. Walking Wise parents and youth are donating time and funding for transportation, packing and distribution.
