Useful Tips

1. Practice with logging in to your homeschool group web site.
2. The “Links Menu” referred to in the help manual are the menu links, such as Calendar, Classifieds, FAQ’s, etc., on your group home page.
3. Remember, every Friday night, each family that has joined the group web site, will receive an email with what has changed on your web site in the past week.

Check List

1. Determine what you want on your family home page. Text, photos, etc.
2. What do you want others in your homeschool group to see when they open your family web site?
3. What photos do I want on our family web pages?
4. Do I want to grant access to our family web site to family and friends?
5. When should I incorporate designing web sites into our curriculum? What age is appropriate? Homeschool-Life.com recommends ages 9 and higher but only the parents determine readiness.
