

Statements of Faith

PAC Day is an academic environment founded and guided on Christian principles. PAC Day participants and parent-teachers are not required to sign this statement, but are asked not to promote or espouse contrary doctrines or beliefs while attending or teaching.

We believe:

1. The Bible is the inspired and infallible Word of God and constitutes His completed and final revelation to man. The Bible, in its original autograph is without error in whole and in part including theological concepts as well as geographical and historical details.
2. God has existed from all eternity in three persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. Jesus Christ was God come in human flesh being fully God and fully man except without sin.
3. All men are in violation of God's righteous requirements and His holy character both by nature and act and are therefore under His wrath and just condemnation. The central purpose of the coming of Jesus Christ was to pay the penalty for man's sin through His death on the cross. The successful accomplishment of this was attested to by His subsequent visible bodily resurrection.
4. Salvation is offered as a gift and is free to the sinner. This gift must be responded to in individual faith, not trusting in any personal works, but in the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ alone.
5. Marriage is the covenantal union of one man and one woman in permanent sacred fidelity. Though various cultures and customs have evolving definitions of marriage, it is God alone who has ultimate authority to prescribe and describe the marital relationship. We will adhere to and follow the scriptural definition of marriage in the teachings and practices of (Genesis 2:24)
6. We believe we are created in the image of God, both male and female exclusively, which is innate and biologically correct. (Genesis 1:27)
