Summer June Art Camps: - 4 Class Sessions

CLASS # 101 - Animal Portraits in Acrylics/Mixed Media on Canvas Panels

After examining a large collection of animal prints, paintings and photos, students will design an 8" x 10" Animal Portrait in acrylic paints and/or mixed media of their favorite animal on a canvas panel. Beginning with pencil sketches, students will effectively use positive & negative space, color blocking, background/foreground development, and achieve 3D Form through shading techniques and highlights using acrylics and/or mixed media. Each finished 8" x 10" portrait will include Scripture calligraphy of Genesis 1:24 and will be ready for display. All supplies included

This all-time student favorite features traditional 3D Plaster Bas Relief Sculptures where students will learn how to effectively use the Art Elements positive & negative Space, Form, Color, Texture and Art Principle Emphasis as they prepare a plaster surface, carve using clay/sculpture tools on plaster & clay, then turn reliefs into "FRESCOES" by painting. CLASS #107 - Small group therapy- summer intensives

A limited number of spots are available for students who would benefit from Educational Therapy during the summer.

Dysgraphia, Focus, Dyscalculia and automaticity of math facts, Reading Fluency, and Dyslexia all are responsive to intensive therapy.

The placement of students with a therapist occurs after consultation with Mrs. McBreen to discuss needs and expectations. Summer rates are .50/minute with a minimum of two hours/week.

CLASS # 108 - Summer Guided Reading

Is your child reading but reluctantly? Is comprehension questionable? Is reading a slow process? If you know your child needs to read more but you don't have the time or your child just doesn't read on his own,

Reading is more fun when you get to discuss a novel with your peers! There are fabulous books just waiting to be discovered!

Read, listen, discuss, and learn to really enjoy a variety of novels and learn to pull meaning out of the written word. Students will have limited homework that involves answering questions from a paragraph and reading/listening/discussing novels.

Students will vote on the novels the first day and reading will begin day one! The initial novel will be provided.
