- To be a springboard for educational and recreational endeavors

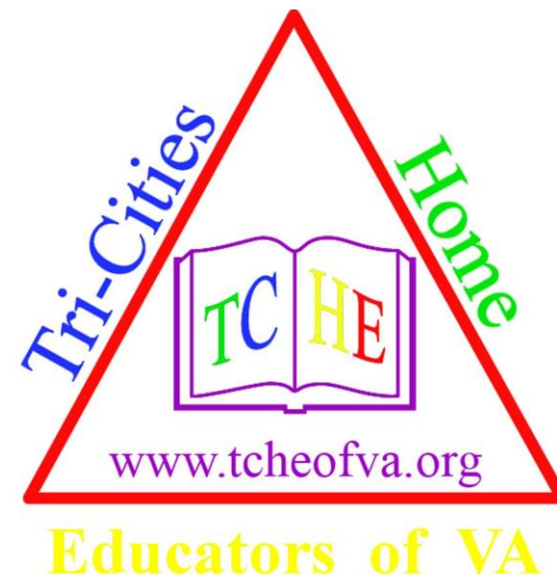
Our Philosophy:
