

Varsity letter program

The varsity letter is awarded for both talent and effort. It is designed to be a valued award for hard work, dedication, and ability. The achievement of a varsity letter is not a right, but rather the result of a personal responsibility to act and behave all season at the varsity level, in a varsity manner, meaning, an above average commitment to the team, the sport, to hard work and to improvement.

Criteria:

Participation in varsity games and practices

Exhibit good sportsmanship and behavior as described in the players code of conduct

Must be in good athletic and academic standing, complete the season and be eligible academically.

An athlete must participate in at least one community service activity per season.

Awards:

- 1) The first time an athlete earns a varsity letter, the athlete will receive a red "N" as well as a metal insert designating the sport.
- 2) If an athlete earns a letter in another sport (the second or third different sport) for the first time, the athlete will receive a metal insert designating that sport.
- 3) If an athlete wins more than one letter in a single sport, the athlete will receive another metal insert designating the sport to place on the letter each of the succeeding years.
- 4) If an athlete is a captain of the sport, a captain's pin will be given to place on the letter.
- 5) All head coaches have final decision on their discretion to letter and athlete.
